## NAPLAN ONLINE 2022

In 2022, the students in Years 3 and 5 will once again sit the NAPLAN tests online. The assessment window for NAPLAN ONLINE covers 9 days to give schools more flexibility in scheduling the use of electronic devices. The Year 3 students will still complete their writing test on paper. The NAPLAN ONLINE assessment window starts Tuesday 10 May and finishes Friday 20 May. NAPLAN ONLINE will continue to assess literacy and numeracy skills that the students are learning through their regular school curriculum.

The school supports parents' rights to opt their children out of these tests. This is a matter for consideration with the Principal and Classroom teacher. Withdrawals are intended to address issues including religious beliefs and philosophical objections to testing, disability and mental health. Parents / Caregivers withdrawal does not constitute exemption. Withdrawn students will be considered as being absent from the testing. Please see the classroom teacher or Mrs Mort if you have concerns about your child sitting the NAPLAN tests. Principals must submit applications, including Parent/Caregiver signatures where applicable, for approval by Thursday 8 April, 2022.

### What is a close contact?

A close contact is someone who has had close interaction with a person with COVID-19 during their infectious period.

- Lives in the same house as you
- Is an intimate partner
- You spent 2 hours+ in a small room where masks have been removed
- 15 mins+ interaction where you were both not wearing a mask
- Is directed by WA Health that they are a close contact
