NAPLAN 2022

Next week NAPLAN testing will begin for the Year 3 and Year 5 students around the country, starting Tuesday 10 May with Writing, followed by Reading 11 May, Conventions of Language 12 May and Numeracy 13 May. Year 3 students will complete their writing test on paper, with all other tests being completed online. Schools are required to have catch up sessions for any students who miss any of the tests on the scheduled day.

Teachers and students have been working diligently preparing for these tests, practising with the online platform and completing the practice tests and we don't for-see any issues with connectivity during the test sessions. We wish all our Year 3 and 5 students good luck during the testing period.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY GRANT/PARTNERSHIP

This year Beechboro Primary School was fortunate enough to win a grant from an organisation called 'Schools Plus'. The aim of this grant is to allow early intervention in the Early Childhood years, with emphasis on fine motor and gross motor-skills, allowing us to employ an Occupational Therapist who will screen students on expected targets such as, cutting, drawing, colouring, pencil grasps etc. After screening they would then be involved in on-site intervention with the students and offer support for classroom teachers to assist your child in the best possible way.

I am pleased to announce that we have partnered with AIM Therapy for Children to provide the screening service and support for your children and our K-PP Teachers and Education Assistants. There is no cost involved to families and all follow up will happen during school hours as part of the child's daily work programme. As part of the screening process parents and guardians will also receive a written report.

It is a great opportunity for us as a school and you as parent/guardians to have the students screened in a first for the Schools Plus Grants programme. We are the only school in Australia who is trialling such a programme through the grant. We hope all K-PP parents/guardians will support this initiative by filling out the consent form that was sent home last Wednesday and returning it to the classroom teacher by Monday 9 May.
