## MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

The past week has been a very busy time for the students in Years 3 and 5 with NAPLAN testing. The students who sat the tests are to be commended for their mature approach to completing the tests. This week we are doing 'catch ups' for the students who were absent last week and have returned this week. The final day at this stage for completing all testing is Friday 20 May.

Can I remind parents that as we are heading into the colder months and flu season, to keep your children home if they wake up feeling unwell and notify the office via email or phone that they will be absent due to illness. We have sent many children home this week soon after arriving at school due to them feeling unwell. COVID is still effecting staff and students and many are displaying symptoms upon arrival to school, which will result in them being sent home. I have just been notified of the testing period for PEAC. All Year 4 students will sit the PEAC test in Term 3 Week 3. A note will go home to parents of Year 4 student's parents advising them of the exact date at the start of Term 3.
