MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

I wish to acknowledge the Whadjuk Noongar people as the traditional custodians of the land Beechboro Primary School stands on. And pay my respects to the Noongar elders past and present, and acknowledge their advice in our teaching and cultural knowledge.

Welcome to the last newsletter for Term Three! Time really has flown so far this year and the students are one week away from finishing Semester One. Reports are written and are being prepared for signing. Can I please take this opportunity to remind parents that the reports that go home are very important documents and that you will be most likely asked to present reports when enrolling. Please store them safely once they come home, so that they can be easily found.

Last Monday the students were entertained by the band Eastwinds as part of the Musica Viva Program. The members of Eastwinds showed students how to harness their creativity by expressing and sharing their personal experiences through music. A Persian ney (flute) and daf (drum) player, a musical instrument inventor and didgeridoo virtuoso, drew on their own diverse cultural and musical backgrounds to create a sound that was unique. During the session teachers and students were given the tools to create and connect to each other through making music on the spot. It was a thoroughly enjoyable incursion, and it was a great opportunity to have the students involved.

The students from Years 4, 5 and 6, also participated in the Winter Carnival and achieved some fantastic results while having a fun day. The soccer B team won their tournament; our netball A division came equal 3rd; the AFL A team came 3rd and the modcross A team came 5th. Congratulations to all the students who represented our great school on the day and to their teachers for all the training involved in getting students ready for the day. A huge thank you also to the family members who went down to Altone Park and West Beechboro PS to support the students.

Yesterday the City of Swan ran a "waste education" incursion about FOGO, which is being introduced throughout 2024 in the community by the City of Swan. The students learned all about recycling, general waste, and FOGO, which stands for "Food Organics and Garden Organics". This incursion was a part of our community partnerships and provided lots of important information for the students about being waste wise.

Their aim is to get students up and actively involved in physical and creative activities through performance and workshop classes.
